A bill to be entitled

An act relating to credit cards; limiting credit card number information on certain receipts; providing application; providing for operation; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. (1) Except as provided in this section, no person, firm, partnership, association, corporation, or limited liability company that accepts credit cards for the transaction of business shall print more than the last five digits of the credit card account number or the expiration date upon any receipt provided to the cardholder.

(2) This section shall apply only to receipts that are electronically printed and shall not apply to transactions in which the sole means of recording the person's credit card number is by handwriting or by an imprint or copy of the credit card.

(3) This section shall become operative on January 1, 2003, with respect to any cash register or other machine or device that electronically prints receipts for credit card transactions that is in use before January 1, 2002.

(4) This section shall become operative on January 1, 2002, with respect to any cash register or other machine or device that electronically prints receipts for credit card transactions that is first put into use on or after January 1, 2002.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
