Section 1. An Office of Inspector General is established in each school district of the state. Each Inspector General shall be appointed by the Governor for a 4-year term. An Inspector General may be reappointed for successive terms. The Inspector General shall be independent of the superintendent of schools and the district school board, but shall cooperate with the school district's ethics commission or body if such entity exists within the school district. The purpose of the Office of Inspector General is to promote accountability, efficiency, and effectiveness within the school district and to prevent and detect fraud and abuse within the school district. The Inspector General shall have the authority to conduct investigations into allegations of waste, fraud, or financial mismanagement within the school district and shall make recommendations to the superintendent and the school board regarding such investigations. The Inspector General shall have access to all information and personnel necessary to perform the duties of the office. The

Inspector General shall have the power to subpoena witnesses, administer oaths, and require the production of records. Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2002.
