Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 1, between lines 20 and 21,

insert:

Section 2. In order to implement Specific Appropriations 1-187 of the 2002-2003 General Appropriations Act, the Secretary of Education, in consultation with the Commissioner of Education, may establish, abolish, or consolidate bureaus, sections, and subsections and reallocate duties and functions within the Department of Education in order to promote the effective and efficient operation of the department and to implement changes to the state system of education initiated by the adoption of the 1998 amendment to Article IX of the State Constitution as implemented by the Legislature in chapter 2001-170, Laws of Florida. Authorized positions and appropriations may be transferred from one budget entity to another as required to implement the reorganization. The secretary may not establish, abolish, or

1 consolidate bureaus, sections, or subsections after December
2 31, 2002, unless such action is approved by the Legislative
3 Budget Commission. The secretary shall provide a report on the
4 reorganization to the President of the Senate, the Speaker of
5 the House of Representatives, the minority leaders of the
6 Senate and the House of Representatives, and the chairs of the
7 education appropriations committees of the Legislature by
8 January 1, 2003. This section expires July 1, 2003.
