A bill to be entitled

An act relating to growth management; providing that the Legislature intends to enact legislation to amend chapters 163 and 380, F.S., relating to the state's system of growth management; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. It is the intent of the Legislature to amend chapters 163 and 380, Florida Statutes, to revise the state's growth-management system, including, but not limited to, providing for streamlined state review of local government comprehensive plans; encouraging public input in comprehensive planning by local governments; encouraging urban infill and redevelopment; seeking state infrastructure funding; modifying the development of the regional-impact process; and defining the appropriate roles of local, regional, and state government in the state's growth-management system.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
