student may participate in interscholastic athletic competition or be a candidate for an interscholastic athletic team if the parent of the student objects in writing to the student undergoing a medical evaluation because such evaluation is contrary to his or her religious tenets or practices. A student who participates without the required medical evaluation pursuant to this paragraph shall not have a cause of action against any person or entity for any injury or other damages suffered by such student arising out of the student's participation, unless the injury or damages are caused by gross negligence, recklessness, or intentional misconduct.
