Since the priorities of the state can change over 20 time, and the House and Senate have undertaken no comprehensive review of the exemptions, the Legislature finds 21 22 that it is in the best interest of the state to have such a 23 review. The Sales Tax Exemption Review Commission is created 24 to provide this needed review of the sales and use tax exemptions in chapter 212. This review will allow the 25 Legislature to examine the purpose and effects of all sales 26 27 and use tax exemptions to ensure that each exemption fulfills an important state interest.
