House Concurrent Resolution

A concurrent resolution renumbering current
Joint Rule 8 and creating a new Joint Rule 8 of
the Joint Rules of the Legislature.

Be It Resolved by the House of Representatives of the State of
Florida, the Senate Concurring:

That current Joint Rule 8 of the Joint Rules of the
Legislature is renumbered as Joint Rule 9 and a new Joint Rule
8 is created to read:

JOINT RULE EIGHT

JOINT LEGISLATIVE SALES TAX EXEMPTION REVIEW COMMITTEE

8.1--Introduction of Committee Bills

At the Regular Session following submission of each
annual report to the President of the Senate and the Speaker
of the House of Representatives recommending the retention,
modification, or repeal of exemptions to the sales and use
tax, the Joint Legislative Sales Tax Exemption Review
Committee must introduce one or more bills presenting for
retention, modification, or repeal those sales and use tax
exemptions that were subject to the review and recommendations
of the committee in the report submitted immediately prior to
the session in which introduced. Each bill so introduced must
be submitted to a vote of the members of each house of the
Legislature during the session in which introduced.
