1 information and records that are confidential or exempt from public disclosure under 21 C.F.R. part 20.61, part 20.62, or 3 part 20.88, or 5 U.S.C. s. 552 are confidential and exempt from s. 119.07(1) and s. 24(a), Art. I of the State Constitution. This section is subject to the Open Government Sunset Review Act of 1995 in accordance with s. 119.15, and shall stand repealed on October 2, 2007, unless reviewed and saved from repeal through reenactment by the Legislature. Section 2. The Legislature finds that the exemption from the public-records law provided in section 1 of this act 11 is a public necessity and that information relating to food-borne illnesses, plans concerning hazard analysis, and 12 information relating to public health which information and 13 plans are confidential under federal law must be exempt from 14 requirements for public disclosure. The Legislature finds that 15 these records, plans, and information are vital to protecting 16 the health and safety of the public and that if this information were made publicly available for inspection or 18 19 copying, the information could be used for purposes that would endanger the public's health. Accordingly, the Legislature 20 finds that the harm to the public which would result from the 21 release of such records, plans, and information substantially 22 outweighs any minimal public benefit derived from public 23 24 disclosure. 25 Section 3. This act shall take effect upon becoming a 26 law.
