(2)(a) Upon the retirement, death, removal, or expiration of the term of office without reelection of a judge of a district court of appeal, or upon the creation of an additional judgeship on a district court of appeal, for an appellate district for which there is a judicial circuit from which there is no judge then serving, such vacancy shall be filled only by a qualified resident from the geographical area of such unrepresented judicial circuit if applications are received from qualified applicants within the unrepresented circuit. If at the time of any vacancy on a district court of appeal there is more than one judicial circuit which is unrepresented by a judge on such district court of appeal, such vacancy shall be filled by a qualified resident of the judicial circuit having the lowest judicial circuit designation number if applications are received from qualified applicants within the unrepresented circuit.
