Paragraphs (c) and (d) of subsection (1) of 17 section 893.13, Florida Statutes, are amended to read: 893.13 Prohibited acts; penalties.--18 19 (1)(c) Except as authorized by this chapter, it is 20 21 unlawful for any person to sell, manufacture, or deliver, or 22 possess with intent to sell, manufacture, or deliver a 23 controlled substance in, on, or within 1,000 feet of the real 24 property comprising a child care facility as defined in s. 25 402.302, or a public or private elementary, middle, or secondary school, or a state, county, or municipal park or 26 27 recreational facility between the hours of 6 a.m. and 12 a.m. Any person who violates this paragraph with respect to: 28 29 1. A controlled substance named or described in s. 30 893.03(1)(a), (1)(b), (1)(d), (2)(a), (2)(b), or (2)(c)4. commits a felony of the first degree, punishable as provided 31 1

A controlled substance named or described in s. 7 893.03(1)(c), (2)(c)1., (2)(c)2., (2)(c)3., (2)(c)5., 8 (2)(c)6., (2)(c)7., (2)(c)8., (2)(c)9., (3), or (4) commits a 9 felony of the second degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084. 10 11 3.
