A bill to be entitled 1 2 An act relating to nurses; providing an appropriation to the Department of Health; 3 4 requiring private match of appropriated funds; 5 providing for grants to hospitals for nurse 6 recruitment and retention; providing for rules; 7 providing eligibility criteria; providing an effective date. 8 9 10 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida: 11 12 Section 1. (1) The sum of \$1 million is appropriated from the General Revenue Fund to the Department of Health. 13 14 Moneys in this appropriation shall be used by that department to make grants to local hospitals for nurse retention and 15 out-of-state recruitment activities during the 2002-2003 16 17 fiscal year. These moneys are subject to a one-for-one match from sources other than the government of this state or one of 18 19 its political subdivisions. Moneys not matched by September 20 30, 2002, revert to the General Revenue Fund. 21 The Department of Health shall accept requests for (2) 22 grants under this act beginning July 1, 2002. The department 23 shall determine grant amounts beginning October 1, 2002, once the amount of the appropriation in subsection (1) which has 24 25 been matched by additional moneys is determined and the 26 department can determine the amount of grant moneys available. 27 (3) The department shall by rule adopt criteria for 28 grant awards. In addition to other criteria, the department 29 shall require that a hospital have experienced an average 30 vacancy rate among nursing positions during the preceding 12 months of 10 percent or more. If the amount available for

distribution is less than the aggregate amount of requests that meet the department's criteria, the department shall make grants pro rata. Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2002. SENATE SUMMARY Appropriates \$1 million to the Department of Health. Any portion of the appropriation not matched one-for-one by private funds by September 30, 2002, reverts to general revenue. Of the amount thus available, the department will make grants to local hospitals having the greatest difficulty in retaining nurses to be used for nurse recruitment and retention.
