A bill to be entitled

An act relating to the Florida Civil Rights Act of 1992; creating s. 760.021, F.S.; authorizing the Attorney General to commence a civil action to obtain damages or other relief for a civil rights violation under certain circumstances; providing a civil penalty; providing for attorney's fees and costs; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 760.021, Florida Statutes, is created to read:

760.021 Enforcement.--If the Attorney General has reasonable cause to believe that:

(1) Any person or group of persons is engaged in a pattern or practice of discrimination; or

(2) Any person or group of persons has been discriminated against and such discrimination raises an issue of general public importance,

the Attorney General may commence a civil action in any appropriate court for damages, injunctive relief, costs, attorney's fees, civil penalties not to exceed \$10,000 per violation, and such other relief as may be appropriate under the circumstances.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.
