On page 1, lines 14-28, delete those lines

and insert:

704.08 Cemeteries; right of ingress and egress for visiting or maintenance.--The relatives and descendants of any person buried in a cemetery, and in the absence of such, the members of any not-for-profit organization duly registered with the Division of Historical Resources of the Department of State and whose purposes include the preservation of Florida's history shall have an easement for ingress and egress for the purpose of visiting the cemetery at reasonable times and in a reasonable manner. The owner of the land may designate the easement. If the cemetery is abandoned or otherwise not being maintained, such relatives and descendants and in the absence of such, the members of such duly registered not-for-profit organizations may request the owner to provide for reasonable maintenance of the cemetery. ~~and~~ If the owner refuses or

 2 descendants, or members of such duly registered organization,
 3 as applicable, shall have the right to maintain the cemetery.
