Subsections (1), (5), (6), and (7) of 10 11 section 849.0931, Florida Statutes, are amended, subsection (13) is renumbered as subsection (14), and a new subsection 12 13 (13) is added to said section, to read: 849.0931 Bingo authorized; conditions for conduct; 14 15 permitted uses of proceeds; limitations.--16 (1) As used in this section: 17 (a) "Bingo game" means and refers to the activity, commonly known as "bingo," in which participants pay a sum of 18 19 money for the use of one or more bingo cards. When the game 20 commences, numbers are drawn by chance, one by one, and 21 announced. The players cover or mark those numbers on the 22 bingo cards which they have purchased until a player receives a given order of numbers in sequence that has been 23 24 preannounced for that particular game. This player calls out 25 "bingo" and is declared the winner of a predetermined prize. 26 More than one game may be played upon a bingo card, and 27 numbers called for one game may be used for a succeeding game 28 or games. 29 "Bingo card" means and refers to the flat piece of (b) 30 paper or thin pasteboard employed by players engaged in the game of bingo. The bingo card shall have not fewer than 24 31

playing numbers printed on it. These playing numbers shall 1 2 range from 1 through 75, inclusive. More than one set of 3 bingo numbers may be printed on any single piece of paper. 4 "Charitable, nonprofit, or veterans' organization" (C) 5 means an organization which has gualified for exemption from federal income tax as an exempt organization under the 6 7 provisions of s. 501(c) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1954 8 or s. 528 of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended; 9 which is engaged in charitable, civic, community, benevolent, 10 religious, or scholastic works or other similar activities; 11 and which has been in existence and active for a period of 3 12 years or more. 13 (d) "Instant bingo" means a game that is played using 14 tickets by which a player wins a prize by opening and removing 15 a cover from the ticket to reveal a set of numbers, letters, 16 objects, or patterns, some of which have been predesignated in 17 advance as prize winners. (e)(d) "Objects" means a set of 75 balls or other 18 precision shapes that are imprinted with letters and numbers 19 20 in such a way that numbers 1 through 15 are marked with the letter "B," numbers 16 through 30 are marked with the letter 21 22 "I," numbers 31 through 45 are marked with the letter "N," numbers 46 through 60 are marked with the letter "G," and 23 numbers 61 through 75 are marked with the letter "O." 24 25 "Package" means a separate set of not more than (f) 26 4,000 instant bingo tickets in which the predetermined minimum 27 prize payout is at least 65 percent of the total receipts from 28 the sale of the entire package. 29 (g)(e) "Rack" means the container in which the objects 30 are placed after being drawn and announced. 31

1 (h)(f) "Receptacle" means the container from which the 2 objects are drawn or ejected. (i)(g) "Session" means a designated set of games 3 4 played in a day or part of a day. 5 (5) Except for instant bingo prizes, which are limited б to those displayed on the ticket, no jackpot may shall exceed 7 the value of \$250 in actual money or its equivalent, and there 8 shall be no more than three jackpots in any one session of 9 bingo. 10 Except for instant bingo, which is not limited by (6) 11 this subsection, the number of days per week during which 12 organizations authorized hereunder may conduct bingo may not 13 exceed two. 14 (7) Except for instant bingo prizes, which are limited 15 to those displayed on the ticket, there shall be no more than 16 three jackpots on any one day of play. All other game prizes may shall not exceed \$50. 17 (13)(a) Instant bingo tickets must be sold at the 18 19 price printed on the ticket, not to exceed \$1. Discounts may 20 not be given for purchases of multiple tickets, nor may 21 tickets be given away free of charge. 22 (b) The sets of numbers, letters, objects, or patterns 23 that have been predesignated as winning combinations for a 24 package of bingo tickets must be posted before the sale of any 25 tickets from that package. 26 (14)(13) Any organization or other person who 27 willfully and knowingly violates any provision of this section 28 is guilty of a misdemeanor of the first degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083. For a second or 29 subsequent offense, the organization or other person is guilty 30 31
