A bill to be entitled
An act relating to high school athletic
activities; requiring students who participate
in such activities to undergo an
electrocardiogram; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Any high school student who engages in
school-sponsored athletic activities must have an
electrocardiogram performed and analyzed by a person who is
licensed as a specialist in that field before participating in
any such activities.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2002.

SENATE SUMMARY

Requires an EKG to be performed on high school students
before they engage in certain school-sponsored athletic
activities.
