15	who complete a minimum 2-year accredited college program to

17	provide safe and competent service to their patients, and
18	WHEREAS, dental hygienists help promote and foster oral
19	hygiene and education, and
20	WHEREAS, there are 6,000 licensed dental hygienists in
21	this state, and
22	WHEREAS, the Florida Dental Hygiene Association
23	represents the profession of dental hygiene, and
24	WHEREAS, members of the Florida Dental Hygiene
25	Association have traveled to Tallahassee on February 21, 2002,
26	to sponsor Smile Day, NOW, THEREFORE,

28	Be It Resolved by the Senate of the State of Florida:
