Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 92, between lines 3 and 4,

insert:

Section 31. In order to implement specific appropriations 2195-2202 of the 2002-2003 General Appropriations Act, subsection (3) and paragraph (a) of subsection (5) of section 443.111, Florida Statutes, are amended to read:

443.111 Payment of benefits.--

(3) WEEKLY BENEFIT AMOUNT.--

(a) An individual's "weekly benefit amount" ~~is shall~~ be an amount equal to one twenty-sixth of the total wages for insured work paid during that quarter of the base period in which such total wages paid were the highest, but not less than \$32 or more than \$275. This amount may also be cited as the "base benefit amount."

(b) For fiscal year 2002-2003 only, claims with

 21 years beginning October 1, 2002, through June 30, 2004, the
 22 total amount of benefits is increased by January 1, 2000,
