Pickard and the Hearing Research 21 Institute were instrumental in the creation and passage of this legislation, NOW, THEREFORE, 22 23 24 Be It Resolved by the Senate of the State of Florida: 25 26 That February 28, 2002, is recognized as Infant Hearing 27 Awareness Day and the Florida Senate commends the Hearing 28 Research Institute and its Medical Director, Robert E. 29 Pickard, for their efforts to alleviate newborn hearing loss. 30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this resolution, with the Seal of the Senate affixed, be presented to Robert E. 31
