A bill to be entitled

An act relating to drug abuse prevention;
providing that certain licensees who violate
drug prescription standards shall be referred
to the Attorney General for potential criminal
prosecution; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Any licensee who violates section
458.331(1)(q), Florida Statutes, section 459.015(1)(t),
Florida Statutes, section 461.013(1)(o), Florida Statutes, or
section 466.028(1)(p), Florida Statutes, shall be referred by
the appropriate regulatory board to the Attorney General for a
determination of whether to prosecute the licensee for
trafficking in illegal drugs under section 893.135, Florida
Statutes.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2002.

SENATE SUMMARY

Provides that certain medical licensees who violate drug
prescription proscriptions shall be referred to the
Attorney General for a determination of whether to
prosecute for trafficking in illegal drugs.
