27	identification card unless possession by such person has been

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state or jurisdiction issuing licenses recognized in this 1 state for the operation of a motor vehicle; or 2 3 (c) Knowingly to have in his or her possession any 4 instrument in the similitude of an identification card issued 5 by the department or its duly authorized agents or those of 6 any state or jurisdiction issuing identification cards 7 recognized in this state for the purpose of indicating a person's true name and age; or-8 9 (d) Knowingly sell, manufacture, or deliver, or knowingly offer to sell, manufacture, or deliver, a blank, 10 forged, stolen, fictitious, counterfeit, or unlawfully issued 11 12 driver's license or identification card, or an instrument in 13 the similitude of a driver's license or identification card, 14 unless that person is authorized to do so by the department. A 15 violation of this section may be investigated by any law enforcement agency, including the Division of Alcoholic 16 17 Beverages and Tobacco. 18 19 The term "driver's license" includes a driver's license issued by the department or its agents or a driver's license issued 20 by any state or jurisdiction that issues licenses recognized 21 in this state for the operation of a motor vehicle. The term 22 "identification card" includes any identification card issued 23 by the department or its agents or any identification card 24 issued by any state or jurisdiction that issues identification 25 26 cards recognized in this state for the purpose of indicating a person's true name and age. This subsection does not prohibit 27 a person from possessing or displaying another person's 28 29 driver's license or identification card for a lawful purpose. Except as otherwise provided in this subsection, 30 (6) any person who violates any of the provisions of this section 31 2

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is guilty of a felony of the third degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084. However, Any person who violates paragraph (5)(a) by giving a false age in any application for a driver's license or identification card or who violates paragraph (5)(b) by possessing a driver's б license, identification card, or any instrument in the similitude thereof, on which the date of birth has been altered is guilty of a misdemeanor of the second degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083. Any person who violates paragraph (1)(d) commits a felony of the third degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082, s. 775.083, or s. 775.084. Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 2002.
