1 After completing 3 years of continuous service an (b) 2 affidavit of certification on a form approved by the 3 commission shall be submitted to the state attorney's office 4 or the public defender's office as the case may be. The 5 affidavit of certification shall, upon approval of the state attorney or public defender, be submitted to the commission. 6 7 (c) Upon receipt of the certificate, the commission 8 may begin yearly payments in the amount of \$3,000 to the 9 government student loan on behalf of the qualified assistant state attorney or assistant public defender named in the 10 11 certificate. (d) Upon completion of 6 years of continuous service 12 13 the loan assistance payment amount shall increase to \$5,000. 14 After 12 years of continuous service or upon completion of the 15 payment of the student loan, whichever occurs first, loan 16 assistance shall cease.
