- **7. Prior Legislative History:** None in this case. However, HB 85 by Representative Betancourt is a bill arising from the same incident but involving a different claimant.
- **B. Procedural Summary:** The claimant and the county reached a settlement agreement after the complaint was filed in this case.
- C. Facts of Case: Millie Jackson was a passenger on a Miami-Dade County transit bus on December 7, 1999. At approximately 11:23 p.m., the bus ran a red light and struck a Miami-Dade Police vehicle. Both the bus driver and the police officer were agents of the county so the county did not contest liability in this case. Ms. Jackson suffered a herniated disc because of the accident. Ms. Jackson filed suit and the parties reached a settlement after the complaint was filed. The claimant presented evidence of approximately \$17,000 in medical bills. Further the claimant presented evidence of \$12,000 \$13,000 in lost wages.
