Section 120. The Agency for Health Care Administration, in cooperation with Children's Medical Services Program in the Department of Health, shall conduct a study of health care services provided to the medically fragile or medical-technology-dependent children in the state and conduct a pilot program in Dade County to provide subacute pediatric transitional care to a maximum of 30 children at any one time. The purpose of the study and the pilot program are to determine ways to permit medically fragile or medical-technology-dependent children to successfully make a transition from acute care in a health care institution to live with their families when possible, and to provide cost-effective, subacute transitional care services.
