Section 54. Subsections (1) and (2) of section  
765.512, Florida Statutes, are amended to read:

765.512 Persons who may make an anatomical gift.--

(1) Any person who may make a will may give all or  
part of his or her body for any purpose specified in s.  
765.510, the gift to take effect upon death. An anatomical  
gift made by an adult donor and not revoked by the donor as  
provided in s. 765.516 is not irrevocable and may ~~does not~~  
require the consent or concurrence of a family member,  
guardian, representative ad litem, or health care surrogate  
~~any person~~ after the donor's death.

(2) If the decedent has executed an agreement  
concerning an anatomical gift, by ~~including~~ signing an organ  
and tissue donor card, by expressing his or her wish to donate

1 in a living will or advance directive, or by signifying his or  
2 her intent to donate on his or her driver's license or in some  
3 other written form has indicated his or her wish to make an  
4 anatomical gift, and in the absence of actual notice of  
5 contrary indications by the decedent, the document is evidence  
6 of legally sufficient informed consent to donate an anatomical  
7 gift and is legally binding. Any surrogate designated by the  
8 decedent pursuant to part II of this chapter may give all or  
9 any part of the decedent's body for any purpose specified in  
10 s. 765.510.
