For the purpose of replacing the 19 20 state accounting and cash management systems, the term 21 "commodity" includes accounting software and implementation 2.2 and project management services. "Commodity" also includes 23 interest on deferred-payment commodity contracts approved 24 pursuant to s. 287.063 entered into by an agency for the 25 purchase of other commodities. However, commodities purchased 26 for resale are excluded from this definition. Further, a 27 prescribed drug, medical supply, or device required by a licensed health care provider as a part of providing health 28 29 services involving examination, diagnosis, treatment, prevention, medical consultation, or administration for 30 clients at the time the service is provided is not considered 31
