2 paragraph is effective only for calendar year 2004 and expires
3 on January 1, 2005.

4 (c) The contrary notwithstanding, beginning January 1,
5 2005, and each calendar year thereafter, each municipality
6 that receives the insurance premium tax and has met all the
7 minimum pension benefits required in chapter 99-1, Laws of
8 Florida, must expend its total annual distribution of such
9 insurance premium tax to provide additional or extra benefits
10 for its police officers. The term "extra or additional
11 benefits" means benefits that are greater than those provided
12 to the general employees of March 12, 1999, and thereafter.

13 (d) The requirements of this subsection do not apply
14 to a municipality that uses its insurance premium tax
15 distribution for supplemental benefits. Furthermore, the
16 Municipal Police and Firefighters Trust Fund Office shall
17 determine the appropriate distribution and shall notify the
18 respective municipality.
