Section 1. Section 40.01, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

40.01 Qualifications of jurors.--Jurors shall be taken from the male and female persons at least 18 years of age who are citizens of the United States and legal residents of this state and who are registered electors of their respective counties and who possess a driver's license or identification card issued by the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles pursuant to chapter 322 or who have executed the

Subsection (1) of section 40.011, Florida Statutes, is amended to read: 2 3 40.011 Jury lists.--(1) On or before January 1, 1993, and each year 4 5 thereafter by January 1, the Department of Highway Safety and 6 Motor Vehicles shall deliver to the clerk of the circuit court 7 in each county a list of names, along with mailing addresses and dates of birth, of each person 18 years of age or older 9 whose name appears in the department database and whose 10 address is in that county. By January 1, 1992, the department 11 shall begin the process of identifying persons whose names appear in the department database who are not citizens of the 12 United States and legal residents of this state for the 13 purpose of jury selection. In addition, the department may furnish 10 to the courts, for the purpose of establishing jury selection 11 lists, the names, addresses, and birth dates of the persons of 12 the entire state or any portion thereof by age group having 13 identification cards issued by the department.
