The expressway authority shall 5 negotiate with the top-ranked proposer in good faith, and if the expressway authority is not satisfied with the results of 6 7 said negotiations, the expressway authority may, at its sole 8 discretion, terminate negotiations with said proposer. If these negotiations are unsuccessful, the expressway authority 9 10 may go to the second and lower-ranked firms in order using 11 this same procedure. If only one proposal is received, the 12 expressway authority may negotiate in good faith, and if the 13 expressway authority is not satisfied with the results of said 14 negotiations, the expressway authority may, at its sole 15 discretion, terminate negotiations with the said proposers.
