11	Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

13	Section 1. Each district school board, community
14	college district board of trustees, and university board of
15	trustees shall establish, by rule and pursuant to guidelines
16	of the Florida Board of Education, policies regarding
17	currently enrolled students who are called to, or enlist in,
18	active military service. Such policies shall provide that any
19	student enrolled in a postsecondary course or courses at an
20	area technical center, a public community college, a public
21	college, or a state university shall not incur academic or
22	financial penalties by virtue of performing military service
23	on behalf of our country. Such student shall be permitted the
24	option of either completing the course or courses at a later
25	date without penalty or withdrawing from the course or courses
26	with a full refund of fees paid. If the student chooses to
27	withdraw, the student's record shall reflect that the
28	withdrawal is due to active military service.
29	Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2002.
