A bill to be entitled
An act relating to determination of resident
status for tuition purposes; amending s.
240.1201, F.S.; providing for classification as
residents of dependent children of certain
active duty members of the Armed Services;
providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Paragraph (b) of subsection (10) of section
240.1201, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

240.1201 Determination of resident status for tuition
purposes.--Students shall be classified as residents or
nonresidents for the purpose of assessing tuition fees in
public community colleges and universities.

(10) The following persons shall be classified as
residents for tuition purposes:

(b) Active duty members of the Armed Services of the
United States, ~~and their spouses,~~ and their dependent children
attending a public community college or university within 50
miles of the military establishment where they are stationed,
if such military establishment is within a county contiguous
to Florida.

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2002.

Includes dependent children of certain active duty
