The employing agency must document that the continuing training or education 23 24 is job-related and consistent with the needs of the employing 25 agency. The employing agency must maintain and submit, or electronically transmit, the documentation to the commission, 26 27 in a format approved by the commission. 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completion of continuing training or education; 1 2 (b) A procedure for reactivation of the certification 3 of an officer who is not in compliance with this section; and 4 (c) A remediation program supervised by the training 5 center director within the geographic area for any officer who 6 is attempting to comply with the provisions of this subsection 7 and in whom learning disabilities are identified.
