WHEREAS, after a thorough investigation by both the Miami-Dade County Police Homicide Investigation Unit and the Miami-Dade Transit Authority, both agencies concluded that the driver of the bus was negligent and caused the accident, and

WHEREAS, neither agency found that Officer Calderon was negligent in any way, and there is no other evidence of contributory fault on the part of Officer Calderon, and

WHEREAS, Officer Calderon was survived by his 29-year-old wife, Jessica Ann Calderon, and their children,
