Amendment to Amendment (324671) (with title amendment)

On page 1, of the amendment between lines 13 and 14,

insert:

Section 1. Excess revenue from civil penalties imposed for traffic violations.--If any municipality or county receives more than 24 percent of its total actual annual revenue for the prior fiscal year, excluding grant revenue, from civil penalties collected from traffic violations, any amount in excess of 24 percent shall be sent to the Department of Highway Safety and Motor Vehicles to be distributed in the following manner:

(1) Fifty percent shall be deposited into the Highway Safety Operating Trust Fund.

(2) Fifty percent shall be deposited into the State Transportation Trust Fund.
