insert after "must": ensure that the hydrant is installed in compliance with the provisions of National Fire Protection Association Standard 24, Standard for the Installation of Private Fire Service Mains and Their Appurtenances, and is inspected and maintained in compliance with the provisions of National Fire Protection Association Standard 25, Standard for the Inspection, Testing, and Maintenance of Water-Based Fire Protection Systems, the edition currently adopted by the State Fire Marshal pursuant to its code and standards adoption authority in Chapter 633. A person who owns a private fire hydrant must produce a valid and continuing maintenance contract with a plumbing contractor licensed under Chapter 489, an underground utility contractor licensed under Chapter 489, or in the case the private hydrant is part of a fire suppression system, a fire protection contractor licensed under Chapter 633. Upon failure to produce a valid
