A bill to be entitled

An act relating to crimes involving public or commercial transportation; providing that it is a third-degree felony to attempt to obtain or obtain any means of public or commercial transportation or conveyance with the intent to commit a felony or facilitate the commission of a felony; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Prohibited use of a means of public or commercial transportation or conveyance.--A person may not attempt to obtain, solicit to obtain, or obtain any means of public or commercial transportation or conveyance, including any vessel, aircraft, railroad train, or commercial motor vehicle defined in section 316.033(66), Florida Statutes, with the intent to use the means of public or commercial transportation or conveyance to commit a felony or facilitate the commission of a felony. A violation of this section is a felony of the third degree, punishable as provided in section 775.082, section 775.083, or section 775.084, Florida Statutes.

Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 2002.

SENATE SUMMARY

Provides that it is a felony of the third degree to attempt to obtain, solicit, or obtain any means of public or commercial transportation or conveyance with the intent to use the means of public or commercial transportation or conveyance to commit a felony or facilitate the commission of a felony.
