Section 784.062, Florida Statutes, is created to read: 17 18 784.062 Misuse of laser lighting devices .--19 (1) As used in this section, the term "laser lighting 20 device" means a hand-held device, not affixed to a firearm, 21 which emits a laser beam that is designed to be used by the 22 operator as a pointer or highlighter to indicate, mark, or 23 identify a specific position, place, item, or object. (2) Any person who knowingly and willfully shines, 24 points, or focuses the beam of a laser lighting device at a 25 26 law enforcement officer, engaged in the performance of his or 27 her official duties, in such a manner that would cause a 28 reasonable person to believe that a firearm is pointed at him 29 or her commits a misdemeanor of the second degree, punishable as provided in s. 775.082 or s. 775.083. 30 31 Section 2. This act shall take effect October 1, 2002.
