Senate Amendment (with title amendment)

On page 1, between lines 26 and 27,

insert:

(4) Notwithstanding the provisions of Subsection (2), a student may participate in organized athletics, if the student, or if the student is under 18 years of age, the student's parent or guardian, objects in writing to the student undergoing a complete physical assessment because such assessment is contrary to his or her religious tenets or practices, provided that no person or entity shall be held liable for any injury or other damages suffered by such student as a result of waiver of the physical assessment and EKG, except if that injury or damage results from gross negligence, recklessness, or intentional misconduct.
