**Senate Amendment**

On page 9, lines 18-31, delete those lines

and insert:

(8) The Department of Legal Affairs shall establish a 14-member prescription-monitoring program advisory council to assist it in identifying drugs of abuse for inclusion in the monitoring system and in implementing the system.

(a) The Governor shall appoint members to serve on the advisory council. The members of the council shall include the Attorney General or his or her designee who shall serve as the chairperson; the Secretary of Health or his or her designee; the executive director of the Department of Law Enforcement or his or her designee; the director of the Office of Drug Control within the Executive Office of Governor or his or her designee; a physician who is licensed in this state under chapter 458, Florida Statutes, who is recommended by the Florida Medical Association; a physician who is licensed in this state under chapter 458 or chapter 459, Florida Statutes,
