On page 1, line 27, delete that line

and insert:

Section 2. When the probable-cause panel determines that probable cause does not exist, the Legislature finds that it is a public necessity to exempt from public-disclosure a complaint filed under section 246.111, Florida Statutes, and all information obtained in the course of investigation of a complaint filed under section 246.111, Florida Statutes. The Legislature finds that it is a public necessity to exempt the proceedings of the probable-cause panel under section 246.111, Florida Statutes, from public-disclosure requirements. The exemption prevents unfounded complaints and investigations from being used to damage the good name of an individual or entity. The public interest would be protected because the complaint, all information obtained in the course of the investigation of the complaint, and a record of the proceedings of the probable-cause panel shall be subject to

3 Section 3. This act shall take effect January 7, 2003,
4 if Senate Bill 2022, relating to independent postsecondary
