A bill to be entitled
An act relating to public records and meetings;
creating s. 246.1112, Florida Statutes;
exempting certain investigatory records of the
Commission for Independent Education; providing
for future review and repeal; providing an
effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 246.1112, Florida Statutes, is
created to read:

246.1112 Actions against a licensee and other
penalties; confidentiality of information.--The complaint and
all information obtained by the Commission for Independent
Education in the course of an investigation under s. 246.111
is confidential and exempt from s. 119.07(1), and s. 24(a),
Art. I of the State Constitution, for a maximum of 10 days
after the probable-cause panel declares a finding of probable
cause, and the proceedings of that probable-cause panel are
exempt from s. 286.011 and s. 24(b), Art. I of the State
Constitution until the panel declares a finding of probable
cause. This section is subject to the Open Government Sunset
Review Act of 1995 in accordance with s. 119.15, and shall
stand repealed October 2, 2007, unless renewed and saved from
repeal through reenactment by the Legislature.

Section 2. This act shall take effect January 7, 2003.

STATEMENT OF SUBSTANTIAL CHANGES CONTAINED IN
COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR
Senate Bill 660

Creates an exemption for the complaint and all information obtained by the Commission for Independent Education in the course of an investigation under s. 246.111, F.S.

Creates a meeting exemption for no more than 10 days after the probable cause panel declares a finding of probable cause

Removes statement of public necessity.
