Section 893. Subsection (2) of section 218.36, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:

218.36 County officers; record and report of fees and disposition of same.--

(2) Effective October 1, 2002, on or before the date for filing the annual report, the tax collector, sheriff, supervisor of elections, and property appraiser ~~each county officer~~ shall pay into the county general fund all money in excess of the sum to which he or she is entitled under the provisions of chapter 145. Whenever a tax collector has money in excess, he or she shall distribute the excess to each governmental unit in the same proportion as the fees paid by the governmental unit bear to the total fee income of his or her office. Any excess held by a property appraiser shall be divided into parts for each governmental unit which was billed

1 and which paid for the operation of the property appraiser's
2 office in the same proportion as the governmental units were
