Senate Amendment

On page 6, line 21, through
page 7, line 4, delete those lines

and insert:

5. Projects that make use of private lands to reduce nutrient loadings or concentrations within a basin by one or more of the following methods: restoring the natural hydrology of the basin, restoring wildlife habitat or impacted wetlands, reducing peak flows after storm events, increasing aquifer recharge, or protecting range and timberland from conversion to development are eligible for grants available under this section from the coordinating agencies. For projects of otherwise equal priority, funding priority will be given to those projects that make best use of the methods outlined above that involve public-private partnerships or that obtain federal match money. Grant applications may be submitted by any person, and eligible projects may include, but are not limited to, the purchase of conservation and
