Section 372.27, Florida Statutes, is 9 amended to read: 372.27 Silver Springs and Rainbow Springs, etc., 10 11 closed to all fishing .-- It is unlawful for any person to take 12 any fish within Marion County, from the waters of Rainbow Springs and Rainbow River (formerly known as Blue Springs and 13 14 Blue Springs River) within a radius of 1 mile from the head of 15 Rainbow said Spring, except from the shore of the Rainbow River, or from the waters of Silver Springs or Silver Springs 16 Run from the head of Silver Springs said spring to its 17 18 junction with the Oklawaha River. However, + provided, that 19 the Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission may remove or 20 cause to be removed any gar, mud fish, or other predatory fish from either spring or river when in its judgment their removal 21 is desirable. 22 23 Section 2.
