> A bill to be entitled An act relating to education; amending s. 236.687, F.S.; specifying the maximum class size for kindergarten through grade three in public schools; providing priorities for school districts in complying with the requirements for class size; specifying the maximum class size for grades four through 12 in public schools; requiring school districts to employ a licensed social worker and a licensed psychologist for each elementary and secondary school; providing an appropriation; providing an effective date.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

Section 1. Section 236.687, Florida Statutes, is amended to read:
236.687 Maximum class size goals.--
(1) Beginning with the 2002-2003 school year and thereafter, the class size for $1 t$ shall be the goal of the fegislature and each school district that each elementary school in each the school district in beginning with kindergarten through grade three may elass sizes not exceed 20 students, with a ratio of one full-time-equivalent full-time equivalent teacher per 20 students; however, exept that only in the case of critically low-performing schools as identified by the Commissioner of Education, the goal in kindergarten through grade three shall be a ratio of one full-time equivalent teacher per 15 students. For purposes of any funding in the General Appropriations Act to comply with this

subsection meet these goals, the district shall give priority
to identified critically low-performing schools in the
district. Second priority for the use of any funds designated
for complying with this subsection meeting these goals shall
be for kindergarten through grade one. Third priority for the
use of any funds designated for complying with this subsection
meeting these goals shall be for grades two and three.
(2) Beginning with the 2002-2003 school year and
thereafter, the class size for each school in each school
district in grades four through 12 may not exceed 25 students,
with a ratio of one full-time-equivalent teacher per 25
students.
Section 2. School districts to employ school social
workers and psychologists.--Beginning with the 2002-2003
school year and thereafter, each school district in the state
shall employ a psychologist licensed under chapter 490,
Florida Statutes, and a social worker licensed under chapter
491, Florida Statutes, for each elementary and secondary
school in the district. The psychologist and social worker
shall be available to counsel students during regular school
hours.
Section 3. The sum of $\$$ is appropriated from
the General Revenue Fund to the district school boards for the
purpose of carrying out this act during the 2002-2003 fiscal
year.
Section 4. This act shall take effect upon becoming a
law.
