Effective 17 18 July 1, 1989, employers may not report such payments to the 19 division as salary, and may not make retirement contributions 20 on such payments. 21 (b) Bonuses shall include, but not be limited to, the 22 following: 1. Exit bonus or severance pay. 23 24 2. Longevity payments in conformance with the 25 provisions of paragraph (a). 26 3. Salary increases granted pursuant to an employee's 27 agreement to retire, including increases paid over several 28 months or years prior to retirement. 29 4. Payments for accumulated overtime or compensatory time, reserve time, or holiday time worked, if not made within 30 11 months of the month in which the work was performed. 31 2
