 - h. By a urologist for lithotripsy services.
- i. By a dentist for dental services performed by an employee of or health care provider who is an independent contractor with the dentist or group practice of which the dentist is a member.
- j. By a physician for infusion therapy services to a patient of that physician or a member of that physician's group practice.
- k. By a nephrologist for renal dialysis services and supplies, except laboratory services.
- 1. By a health care provider whose principal professional practice consists of treating patients in their private residences for services to be rendered in such private residences. For purposes of this sub-subparagraph, the term "private residences" includes patient's private homes, independent living centers, and assisted living facilities, but does not include skilled nursing facilities.

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this act, this act shall take effect July 1, 2002.
