A bill to be entitled

An act relating to community mental health services; requiring that the Department of Children and Family Services use certain funds to expand the provision of community mental health services; requiring the department to submit an implementation plan for the use of funds in each fiscal year to the Governor, the President of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives; prohibiting the release of funds for new community mental health services until the implementation plan is approved by the appropriations committees of the Legislature; requiring that the implementation plan include a schedule for phasing in new community mental health services; requiring the department to submit reports concerning its progress toward expanding community mental health services; requiring that certain crisis services and mental health services be provided by the state's community mental health system by specified dates; providing an effective date.

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Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Florida:

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Section 1. (1) Pursuant to the General Appropriations

Acts for the 2001-2002 and 2002-2003 fiscal years, funds

appropriated to the Department of Children and Family Services

for the purpose of expanding community mental health services

must be used to implement programs that emphasize treatment

services, rehabilitative services, support services, and case-management services, as defined in section 394.67(16), Florida Statutes. Following the 2002-2003 fiscal year, the Department of Children and Family Services must continue to expand the provision of these community mental health services.

- (2)(a) The Department of Children and Family Services shall complete an implementation plan for the use of funds appropriated for this purpose. The implementation plan must include a schedule for phasing-in the new community mental health services in each service district of the department and must describe how the new services will be integrated and coordinated with all current community-based health and human services.
- (b) By September 1 of each year, the Department of Children and Family Services must submit to the Governor, the President of the Senate, and the Speaker of the House of Representatives the implementation plan for any new community mental health program for which funds were appropriated under the General Appropriations Act for the then-current fiscal year. Notwithstanding section 216.192(1), Florida Statutes, the Comptroller may not release funds appropriated for new community mental health services until the appropriations committees of the Legislature approve the implementation plan submitted by the department. This paragraph does not apply to a special legislative project designated for a specific geographic area.
- (3) On October 1, 2002, and on October 1, 2003, the

 Department of Children and Family Services shall submit a

 report to the Governor, the President of the Senate, and the

 Speaker of the House of Representatives concerning the

progress made toward expanding the provision of community 1 mental health services as required by subsection (1) during 2 3 the prior fiscal year. (4) By January 1, 2004, the crisis services defined in 4 5 section 394.67(4), Florida Statutes, shall be implemented, as 6 appropriate, in the state's public community mental health 7 system to serve children and adults who are experiencing an 8 acute mental or emotional crisis, as defined in section 9 394.67(18), Florida Statutes. By January 1, 2006, the mental health services defined in section 394.67(16), Florida 10 11 Statutes, shall be implemented, as appropriate, in the state's 12 public community mental health system to serve adults and 13 older adults who have a severe and persistent mental illness and to serve children who have a serious emotional disturbance 14 15 or mental illness, as defined in section 394.492(6), Florida 16 Statutes. 17 Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a 18 law. 19 20 21 SENATE SUMMARY Requires the Department of Children and Family Services to expand community mental health services that emphasize treatment, rehabilitation, support, and case-management services. Requires that the department submit an implementation plan for expanding such services to the Governor and Legislature by September 1 of each year. Requires that the plan include a schedule for phasing-in new community mental health services in the department's service districts. Prohibits the Comptroller from releasing funds appropriated for new community mental health services until the implementation plan is approved 22 23 24 25 26 health services until the implementation plan is approved 27 by the appropriations committees of the Legislature. Requires that the department submit reports to the 28 Governor and Legislature concerning the progress made toward expanding community mental health services. Requires certain crisis services and mental health 29

services to be implemented, as appropriate, in the state's community mental health system by specified dates. (See bill for details.)

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
