House Joint Resolution 1 2 A joint resolution proposing an amendment to Section 7 of Article III of the State 3 Constitution, relating to the passage of bills 4 by the Legislature, to require a specified 5 review period for proposed legislation prior to 6 7 final passage. 8 9 Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Florida: 10 11 That the amendment to Section 7 of Article III of the 12 State Constitution set forth below is agreed to and shall be 13 submitted to the electors of Florida for approval or rejection 14 at the general election to be held in November 2002: 15 SECTION 7. Passage of bills. -- Any bill may originate 16 in either house and after passage in one may be amended in the other. It shall be read in each house on three separate days, 17 unless this rule is waived by two-thirds vote; provided the 18 19 publication of its title in the journal of a house shall satisfy the requirement for the first reading in that house. 20 On each reading, it shall be read by title only, unless 21 2.2 one-third of the members present desire it read in full. With 23 the exception of general appropriation bills, including 24 conference reports therefor, subject to the seventy-two hour 25 public review period pursuant to Section 19 of this Article, and with the exception of concurrent resolutions or 26 resolutions relating to extension of a session or legislative 27 28 organization or procedures, all bills, joint resolutions, 29 concurrent resolutions, resolutions, memorials, and conference reports shall be furnished in their final form to each member 30 of the house hearing the measure at least forty-eight hours 31

prior to final passage by that house of the legislature. On 1 2 final passage, the vote of each member voting shall be entered 3 on the journal. Passage of a bill shall require a majority vote in each house. Each bill and joint resolution passed in 4 5 both houses shall be signed by the presiding officers of the б respective houses and by the secretary of the senate and the 7 clerk of the house of representatives during the session or as 8 soon as practicable after its adjournment sine die. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that in accordance with the 9 requirements of s. 101.161, Florida Statutes, the title and 10 11 substance of the amendment proposed herein shall appear on the 12 ballot as follows: 13 REVIEW PERIOD FOR PROPOSED LEGISLATION 14 BEFORE FINAL PASSAGE; EXEMPTIONS 15 Requires all bills, joint resolutions, concurrent 16 resolutions, resolutions, memorials, and conference reports to be furnished in their final form to each member of the house 17 hearing the measure at least forty-eight hours prior to final 18 19 passage by that house of the Legislature. Exempts all general 20 appropriation bills and their conference reports, which are 21 subject to a separate seventy-two hour public review period 22 under the State Constitution, and exempts concurrent resolutions or resolutions relating to extension of a session 23 or legislative organization or procedures. 24 25 26 27 28 29 30 31
