This legislation re-creates the Grants and Donations Trust Fund without modification, effective upon becoming a law. The Grants and Donations Trust Fund, FLAIR #31-2-339, is administered by the Executive Office of the Governor. This fund was created by Chapter 99-18.

The Grants and Donations Trust Fund is used to fund contract and grant activities within the Executive Office of the Governor’s General Office and the Office of Tourism, Trade and Economic Development.
