the governing body of a home rule charter county, or any

government of one or more municipalities in accordance with s. 9, Art. VIII of the State Constitution of 1885, as preserved by s. 6(e), Art. VIII of the State Constitution as revised in 1968 and subsequently amended, the Office of Tourism, Trade, and Economic Development may amend the boundaries of an area designated as an enterprise zone upon the receipt of a resolution adopted by such governing body describing the amended boundaries, so long as the added area does not increase the overall size of the expanded zone more than its original size or 20 square miles, whichever is larger, and is consistent with the categories, criteria, and limitations imposed by s. 290.0055.

Section 2. This act shall take effect upon becoming a law.

HOUSE SUMMARY
